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Child Care Program

It is the mission of the Danville Congregational Church to offer a safe environment for children of the congregation. Childcare is available during worship for children ages birth to 3, whose family is attending worship. It is located downstairs in the nursery. Childcare providers are trained and certified in CPR and First Aid and able to provide the finest care for children and engage them in activities and relationships with others. Parents are welcome to help their children adapt to our nursery and if they need to stay downstairs during worship, hearing devices (to listen to the service) are available in the vestibule.

Cherub Choir

Danville Congregational Church Music Committee offers a cherub choir for children beginning at age 3. The cherub choir rehearses ½ hour before worship begins (9:30 - 10 a.m.) and performs in church 1-2 times monthly. Kim Larose is the director. Youth who have "outgrown" cherub choir are invited to join the adult choir (9:00 a.m. Sunday, 6:30 Thursday p.m.)

Curriculum

Danville Congregational Church uses "<u>Seasons Of The Spirit</u>", an exciting resource to help youth and their leaders engage the Bible, explore the church and world, and experience faith in ever-deepening ways. Combined with several traditional Bible stories, we expect to provide a rich Christian education experience for our youth.

7-12th Grade Sunday School Program

Come together to explore the connections between one's faith and ones daily life. How is our Sunday morning service relevant to our lives, our homes, our community, and our world? How does one construct a meaningful and relevant faith? This facilitated group will use a youth directed approach to explore the question: Where does God go after the Sunday morning service is over? We meet the first 3 Sundays of each month.

Bible Study

We are excited to offer a weekly Bible study with focus discussion centered around the current lectionary scriptures. This group meets Monday evenings at 7:00 downstairs in the church.

Sunday School Teacher Training

On August 27, 2009 the Christian Education Committee will host a 7 p.m. Sunday School Teacher gathering at which the supports and expectations for teachers will be described and the goals of our Christian Education program will be detailed. Teachers will form a team for each Sunday School class. These teaching teams will work together to set and manage their schedule for the year and to create a cohesive, consistent routine for each class. Then they will begin planning and preparation for Sunday School classes.

The Christian Education Committee is also planning weekly Bible study focused on the passages to be covered in the next week's Sunday School lesson, and quarterly socials for Sunday School teachers to build community and enjoy each other's company. Our program is again focusing on conveying the curriculum in meaningful ways for our youth, and on building relationships between themselves and our youth and their families, between our youth and the congregation, between our youth and Jesus Christ, and our youth and God.
